Since probably more than ninety per cent of all bridges are those resting on two supports, this volume is confined to that class. For a beginner the study of bridge design should be largely that of proportioning details according to given specifications, and simple bridges furnish these in endless variety. The plan here adopted is to discuss the details directly in connection with a proposed design, as thus the dependence of one thing upon others is most clearly seen. Railroad bridges are mainly chosen for illustration, but two highway structures for electric-car traffic are given, the subject of...



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
